## The Homily

## The Nicene Creed

**We believe in one God, the Father, the Almighty, maker of heaven and earth,  
of all that is, seen and unseen.**

**We believe in one Lord, Jesus Christ, the only Son of God,  
eternally begotten of the Father,  
God from God, Light from Light,  
true God from true God, begotten, not made,  
of one Being with the Father;  
through him all things were made.**

***For us and for our salvation he came down from heaven,  
was incarnate from the Holy Spirit and the Virgin Mary  
and was made man.***

**For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate;  
he suffered death and was buried.  
On the third day he rose again in accordance with the Scriptures;  
he ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father.  
He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead,  
and his kingdom will have no end.**

**We believe in the Holy Spirit,  
the Lord, the giver of life,  
who proceeds from the Father and the Son,  
who with the Father and the Son is worshipped and glorified,  
who has spoken through the prophets.**

**We believe in one holy catholic and apostolic Church.  
We acknowledge one baptism for the forgiveness of sins.  
We look for the resurrection of the dead,  
and the life of the world to come. Amen.**

## The Prayer of the Faithful

### *The Priest introduces the intercession*

*After each petition the leader will say*

### *Following the prayers for the departed*

Rest eternal grant unto them, O Lord  
**And let light perpetual shine upon them.**  
**May they rest in peace. Amen.**

*The leader invites all to join in a **Prayer for our Parish** (wherever that may be)*

**God our Father,  
through your Holy Spirit  
you grow your Church  
as we proclaim the kingdom of your risen Son.  
Bless us with deepening faith  
and an increase in our community.  
Help us to be a beacon of your love  
to everyone we meet.  
We ask this through Jesus Christ our Lord.  
Amen.**

*We ask for Mary's never-ending intercession and say*

Hail Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with thee;  
blessed art thou among women  
and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus.  
Holy Mary, Mother of God,  
pray for us sinners,  
now and at the hour of our death. Amen.

## The Liturgy of the Eucharist

*As the gifts of bread and wine are prepared on the altar, a hymn is sung*

*At the conclusion of the hymn, the Priest invites the congregation to join in the offering of the Eucharist*

All Pray, my brothers and sisters, that this our sacrifice may be acceptable to God the almighty Father.  
**May the Lord accept this sacrifice at your hands,  
for the praise and glory of his name,  
for our good, and the good of all his holy Church.**

*The Priest says the Prayer over the Gifts*

## **The Eucharistic Prayer**

All      The Lord be with you  
All      **And also with you**  
All      Lift up your hearts  
All      **We lift them to the Lord**  
All      Let us give thanks to the Lord our God  
All      **It is right to give him thanks and praise**

*The Priest sings the Preface for the day, at the end of which we sing*

The mystery of faith

All      **Christ has died:

Christ will come again.**

The Prayer ends in praise of the Father and all acclaim      **Amen.**

## **The Communion Rite**

### **The Lord's Prayer**

*The Priest invites us to join in the Lord's Prayer*

At the Saviour's command and formed by divine teaching, we dare to say

*Together with the people, he continues*

**Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name; thy kingdom come; thy will be done; on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation; but deliver us from evil.**

*The Priest alone continues, saying*

Deliver us, Lord, we pray, from every evil, graciously grant peace in our days, that, by the help of your mercy, we may be always free from sin and safe from all distress, as we await the blessed hope and the coming of our Saviour, Jesus Christ.

*All conclude the prayer, acclaiming*

**For the kingdom, the power and the glory are yours now and for ever.**

*Then the Priest alone says*

Lord Jesus Christ, who said to your Apostles: Peace I leave you, my peace I give you, look not on our sins, but on the faith of your Church, and graciously grant her peace and unity in accordance with your will. Who live and reign for ever and ever.

All      **Amen.**

*The Priest adds*

The peace of the Lord be with you always.  
**And also with you.**

### **Breaking of the Bread**

All      **Lamb of God, you take away the sins of the world, have mercy on us.**  
**Lamb of God, you take away the sins of the world, have mercy on us.**  
**Lamb of God, you take away the sins of the world, grant us peace.**

*The Priest invites those worshipping via the live-stream to receive a spiritual Communion*

This is the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world.  
Blessed are those who are called to his supper.

All      **Lord, I am not worthy to receive you, but only say the word and I shall be healed.**

*and all say together*

**My Jesus, I believe that you  
are present in the Most Holy Sacrament.  
I love you above all things,  
and I desire to receive you into my soul.  
Since I cannot at this moment  
receive you sacramentally,  
come at least spiritually into my heart.  
I embrace you as if you were already there  
and unite myself wholly to you.  
Never permit me to be separated from you. Amen.**

*The Priest and congregation present in the church now receive Holy Communion.*

*During Communion, the choir will sing a motet*

### **Prayer after Communion**

### **The Blessing and Dismissal**

The Lord be with you  
**and also with you.**

.....and the blessing of God almighty, ✠ the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, be among you and remain with you always.  
All      **Amen.**

Go in the peace of Christ.  
All      **Thanks be to God.**

*The Priest will now move to stand before the statue of Our Lady and the 'Angelus' will be sung.*
